



Executive Directive – Daily Symptom Check

Issued by Chancellor Howard Gillman

March 18, 2022

In order to mitigate possible exposure to and transmission of COVID-19 on property controlled by UCI, and to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 within the UCI community, the following requirements apply.

This Executive Directive (“Directive”) is separate from any UC and UCI policies, procedures, and guidelines to the extent such requirements are less restrictive than this Directive.

A. Directive

1. All students and employees are required to complete UCI’s Daily Symptom Check in a manner as directed by UCI.
 - a. Employees who are on an authorized absence or designated as fully remote in UPath and students who have self-attested to the Student Health Center as being fully remote are not required to complete the daily symptom check.
2. Reporting on the daily symptom checker will only be required when a yes response is indicated on the symptom checker.” A yes response can be provided using one of three methods: respond to a daily email, use a smartphone app, or call the COVID Response Center (CRC). Those who answer “Yes” should follow directions provided to them.
3. In some UCI locations, such as the UCI Health System (including UCI Medical Center, Gottschalk Plaza, and other UCI Health clinics), the UCI Student Health Center, and Child Care Services, different protocols may apply and thereby supersede the requirements of this directive.
