



Executive Directive - Travel

Issued by Chancellor Howard Gillman

April 28, 2021

Pursuant to updated travel guidance from UCOP, issued March 12, 2021, the Travel Executive Directive, issued January 29, 2021, is hereby rescinded and replaced with the following.

UCI strongly recommends that non-essential travel be postponed. UCI guidance may change if health conditions change. Please direct any questions to global@uci.edu.

Allowed Travel

UCI follows the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) [definition of essential travel](#), which presently includes travel for work and study. All travelers on UCI-related travel (i.e. to accomplish University business regardless of the source of funding and including campus visitors) must comply with requirements in effect by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Travel Guidance ([CDC.gov/travel](https://www.cdc.gov/travel/)), [CDPH Travel Advisory](#) and notices by Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA) before, during, and upon return from University travel.

Additionally, all international travelers should review the [U.S. Department of State \(DOS\) Travel Advisories](#) related to their destination(s) prior to making travel plans, as well as immediately prior to travel, and they should ensure their travel is registered with the [UC Travel Insurance Program](#).

Because all travel for work and study is allowed by CDPH at this time, no advance COVID-19 related documentation or permissions are needed. However, travelers are still required to comply with other applicable University, campus, and department/unit travel policies and procedures.

Student Travel

All students who wish to travel internationally are required to get advance permission for travel as required in UCI policy Sec. 420-10: Policy for Student International Activities. Covid restrictions will be considered.

UCI's Intercollegiate Athletics competition-related travel, official and unofficial recruiting visits, and recruitment travel by ICA coaches and staff are governed by the ICA plan and NCAA rules, not this directive.
